LAUREL SUMMIT STATE PARK

IS IN WESTMORELAND COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, AT THE INTERSECTION OF LINN RUN ROAD AND LAUREL SUMMIT ROAD. GPS DD: LAT. 40.16082 LONG. -79.1491

Wolf Rocks is a massive, irregularly stacked, sandstone outcropping that hangs off of the edge of the Laurel Ridge summit. Wolf Rocks is an easy 4.5 mile loop hike from tiny Laurel Summit State Park. Wolf Rocks overlook offers a 180 degree view to the west of the Laurel Ridge into the valley back towards Linn Run State Park. Hikers that have hoofed the more than two miles can watch hawks hang on the updrafts along the windy ridge.
