Our last district meeting was held on May 15th of this year. Eight of our thirteen groups were represented, with a total of 14 in attendance. We elected a new Literature Coordinator and appointed a new Treatment Facilities Coordinator. Our Literature Coordinator is helping groups with financial reserves purchase books to be given away at groups with less financial support, as well as starting to collect books for donation to the halfway houses in our district. Our Treatment Facilities Coordinator is making initial contact with hospitals and facilities to begin bringing meetings in to those alcoholics unable to attend outside.

It has been very beneficial to our district to coordinate with our fellow districts, not just for the Day of Sharing, but in re-opening communications for the sharing of ideas. We plan on presenting our bid for the day of sharing at the next quarterly meeting.

We held a very successful St. Patrick's day dance in Westmont in March, and the proceeds were donated forward to our next event, a spaghetti dinner tentatively scheduled for the end of June. Planning has also begun for a district sponsored picnic to be held in July in Windber.
