District 41 is home to 13 Groups and we hold our District Meeting on the 3rd Wednesday of each month at the Hiram G. Andrews Center Seminar Theater, 727 Goucher Street; Johnstown, PA at 6:15 PM.

This quarter we had an average attendance of 14 at each of our district meetings, with eight of our thirteen groups being represented. Meeting attendance is steady across all groups with roughly 30-60 people attending. We had one meeting with lagging attendance back in the winter that has been propped up with support from other meetings on the same night and it's been steadily growing ever since.

Our Treatment Facilities Committee is still making initial contact with hospitals and facilities to begin bringing meetings in, and we should be bringing speaker meetings into the mens and womens halfway houses by the end of September.

We have been planning a long overdue day of sharing with neighboring districts 17, 43 and 44, to be held in Johnstown on September 28th, and are in the final stages of planning. We are prepared to submit a bid to Area 60 at this quarterly meeting. Our goal is to share experience and ideas amongst service minded AA's on how to better serve the treatment and corrections institutions in our districts.

We have no formal activities committee but we've continued a string of activities that started with a St. Patricks day dance back in March, hosting a Spaghetti Dinner and discussion meeting in April that had roughly 70 people in attendance, and a district sponsored picnic and speaker meeting in June with a similar turnout. We've had suggestions for our next event including a dodgeball or softball tournament, game night, a halloween dance, and a holiday party of some kind... more will be revealed.
